



## CPSA ANNOUNCES THREE RECALLS

On September 18, 2023, the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission announced recalls of three items that are commonly used by public agencies.

### [Generac Portable Generators due to Serious Fire and Burn Hazards](#)



#### **Name of Products**

Generac Portable Generators type GP15000E, with model numbers G0057341, G0057342, 005734R1, and 005734R2, and

Generac Portable Generators type GP17500E, with model numbers G0057351, G0057352, 005735R1, and 005735R2.

#### **Hazard**

The recalled generators' fuel tank can fail to vent adequately from the rollover valve, causing the gas tank to build up excess pressure and expel fuel when opened, posing fire and burn hazards.

#### **Remedy**

Users should immediately stop using the generators and contact Generac for a free repair kit.

### [American Honda Motor Recalls Lawnmowers and Pressure Washer Engines Due to Injury Hazard](#)



#### **Name of Products**

Honda HRN216 and HRX217K6 lawnmowers

Honda GCV170/200 G5B pressure washer engines.

#### **Hazard**

Improperly manufactured camshafts in the engines can cause the starter rope to suddenly retract when pulling to start, posing an injury hazard.

#### **Remedy**

Users should immediately stop using the equipment with and contact an authorized Honda Power Equipment dealer to schedule a free inspection and repair.

### [STIHL Recalls MSA 300 Chain Saws Due to Laceration Hazard](#)



#### **Name of Product**

STIHL MSA 300, a battery-powered chain saw with serial numbers lower than 447457319

#### **Hazard**

The chain saw can take longer to brake than expected, posing a laceration hazard.

#### **Remedy**

Users should immediately stop using the chain saw and bring it to an authorized STIHL servicing dealer for the free replacement of the brake drum and brake band.
