



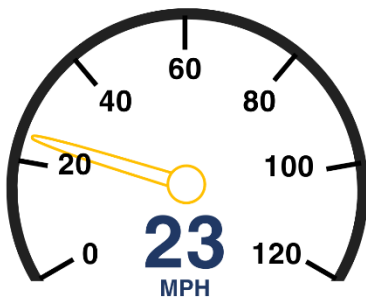

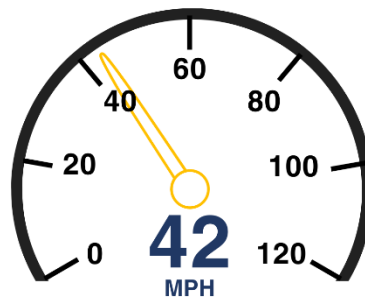

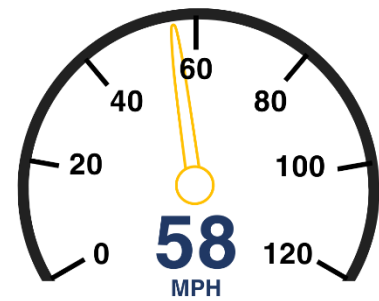

Every six seconds a traffic incident responder is working roadside to keep all road users safe. A small gesture from you makes the big impact of saving responder lives.

Lastly, level up your driving skills by knowing, sharing, and adhering to New Jersey's Move Over Law:

- Move over one lane when approaching a stationary emergency vehicle, tow truck, or other highway safety vehicle with flashing lights.
- If it's not safe to change lanes, slow down below the posted speed.
- Stay alert for responders on the road directing traffic.
