



S:ERVE courses are Emergency Responder Vehicle Education Online EVOC simulation-based training provided by Safety National Insurance.

## THE COURSES AVAILABLE INCLUDE:

- 1. S:ERVE EMS Emergency Responder Vehicle Education
- 2. S:ERVE Fire Emergency Responder Vehicle Education
- 3. S:ERVE Police Emergency Responder Vehicle Education

These courses are focused on code three intersection negotiation. They are created for first responders to refresh perishable driving skills, refresh techniques, concepts, rules and procedural skills that help keep first responders and the public safe in emergency response situations.

The courses include 5 - 30-minute lessons in the following areas:

- Intersection Approach
- Intersection Assessment
- Clearing the Intersection Basic
- Clearing the Intersection Advanced
- Intersection Departure

## 4. S:ERVE - Distracted Driving Course

The Distracted Driving course is simulation-based training focused on limited driving distractions including cell phone use. This course is geared toward ALL operators of municipal vehicles. It's intended to refresh techniques, concepts, rules and procedural skills that help keep drivers safe.

The 30-minute lesson includes distractions inside and outside of a vehicle and strategies for limiting and avoiding distractions.

MSI NOW CLASSES

1. Log into the MEL Safety Institute (MSI) Learning Management System (LMS).

2. If you have previously taken MSI classes, enter your username and password.
