Course Covers:

- Student management and discipline;
- School bus accident and emergency procedures;
- Conducting school bus emergency exit drills;
- Loading and unloading procedures;
- School bus stop loading zone safety;
- Inspecting the school vehicle for students left on board at the end of a route; and The use of a student's education records, including the employee's responsibility to ensure the privacy of the student and his or her records, if applicable.
- (c) In addition to the training requirements in (b) above, employers shall administer to school bus drivers a safety education program that includes defensive driving techniques and railroad crossing

MSI LMS LOGIN

1. **Log into the MSI LMS System.**

- If you have previously taken MSI classes, enter your username and password.
- If you do not know your username and/or password, ask your Senior Reporting Manager to send an LMS activation email or call the MSI Helpline at 866-661-5120.

2. Once logged into the MSI LMS, go to the [Request Training](#) button for a list of online courses.

3. Select the course you wish to complete and scroll down to click the [Submit](#) button.

4. Your course will now show in the Assigned section of your dashboard.

5. Learning transcripts are automatically updated in the MSI LMS and show in the Completed section of your homepage.
