



GREENWORKS TOOLS RECALLS KOBALT YARD BATTERY POWER TOOLS



[Greenworks Tools recalls 24V and 48V Kobalt Yard Power Tools with USB-C batteries due to a risk of serious injury from a fire hazard.](#) The recall includes trimmers, blowers, mowers, chainsaws, and pruning saws with 24V and 48V USB-C batteries. Only products with the USB-C batteries are included in the recall.

The company has received 34 reports of the batteries producing smoke, sparking or catching fire while the batteries are inserted in the tool and charging with the USB-C port.

Charging the lithium-ion batteries through the USB-C port while the batteries are inserted in the yard power tools can cause the batteries to short-circuit, posing a fire hazard.

Users should stop charging the batteries with the USB-C port while the batteries are inserted in the yard power tools immediately and contact Greenworks Tools to receive a free replacement battery. You will need to [Submit a Claim](#) to receive replacement batteries without the USB-C port, a charger adapter, a warning label to affix on the yard power tool, an updated product manual, and a prepaid shipping label along with instructions for returning the recalled batteries.
