



AFTER-ACTION REVIEWS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

COURSE LENGTH: 3 HOURS

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides law enforcement leaders, supervisors, and all police personnel with practical guidance for developing and implementing effective After-Action Review (AAR) practices. Participants will examine how AARs can serve as structured, non-disciplinary discussions following daily operations, near-miss incidents, special events, and training exercises to identify strengths, address areas for improvement, capture lessons learned, and enhance officer safety, accountability, and professional performance. The course will also address when AARs should be conducted, how core review questions can be used to evaluate expectations, outcomes, successes, challenges, corrective actions, and opportunities for agencywide learning, as well as documentation considerations, leadership responsibilities, implementation strategies, and safety and wellness issues, including the distinction between AARs and Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD).

TARGET AUDIENCE: Chiefs of Police, command staff, supervisors, patrol officers, telecommunicators, and officers assigned to special functions, including detectives, School Resource Officers (SROs), Internal Affairs personnel, training officers, and other law enforcement personnel involved in agency operations, supervision, training, accountability, and organizational improvement.
